



Mountain Bike the Tetons is advocating for:

1. Responsible recreation, by:
 - a. minimizing trail density across the landscape by keeping a loop network within a concentrated area (accessible from the AJ trail) and reducing trail density across the Victor parcel.
 - b. supporting a seasonal closure to protect critical wildlife habitat, as deemed appropriate.
 - c. supporting a reduction of trails in Game Creek to promote wildlife habitat and management congruence with the Game Creek RNA.
 - d. improving existing trails to be sustainably built to reduce erosion, improve drainage and to be directional, purpose built mountain bike trails to reduce density, crowding, and concentration of trail junctions.
 - e. facilitating positive trail experience for all users by moving people in one direction in appropriate places to promote positive user interactions while reducing conflict between users.
2. Inclusive trails connecting community, through:
 - a. connective non-motorized singletrack utilizing areas of existing impact and existing access points, with access designations considered.
 1. Access point A: AJ Trail (Private Easement on Cemetery Road), parking is at Cotler Arena. (Open to foot and bike only, non-motorized, non-e-bike)
 2. Access point B: Game Creek Drainage (Non-motorized).
 3. Access point C: Mud Lake Road. (Motorized).
 - b. one route connecting Mud Lake road to two stacked loops above AJ trail (Cemetery Rd), over to Game Creek, all designated non-motorized to comply with the AJ trail access.
 - c. significant consideration of trail design and designation of trails from Game Creek to Mud Lake that allows access for adaptive mountain bike users and e-bikes.
3. A mix of Alternative D & B route designations' on the GIS Draft Map for the Victor parcel
 - a. Trail Numbers and Suggested Designations:

 - UE1437: Limited to Non-Motorized (Alt B&D)
